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## **1. Submission and Peer Review Process**

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Before you submit, you will need:

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- Supplementary information should be submitted in separate files.

If the text, figures, or tables are difficult for you to read, they will also be difficult for the Editors and reviewers, and the Editorial Office will send it back to you for revision. Your manuscript may also be sent back to you for revision if the quality of English language is poor.

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**The Journal of Counseling & Development (JCAD)** publishes articles that inform counseling practice with diverse client populations in a variety of settings as represented by the membership of the American Counseling Association (ACA). Articles should be scholarly; be based on existing literature; and include implications for practice and, when appropriate, implications for public policy related to the counseling profession.

Manuscripts typically fall into one of the following categories, although other kinds of submissions may be appropriate for *JCAD* readers:

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Do not use footnotes or endnotes in the article; incorporate any such material into the text.
